Welcome to Latvia, Jelgava. 25th Baltic States Sports Games of Vocational Education

The Baltic States – Estonian, Latvian and Lithuanian - sports games in vocational education aim is to promote the growth of athletic results as well as to strengthen the friendship between the young people, educators, educational institutions and the management.

How did it all begin and how it continues...

Back in June of 1993, on a hot summer day in Cesis competitions of Latvian vocational education's sports club "AMI" took place - organized together with Cesis Vocational Secondary School No. 4 (Headmaster A.Māsēns, sports organizer A.Beļakovs) and the employees. Team from Tartu Technical School, together with headmaster Vladimir Šokman and sports teacher Tiit Kaber, also took part in. V. Šokman was the Deputy Chairman of the Board of Directors of the Vocational Education Institutions in Estonia.

For some time I (I.Bukovska) had an idea about the necessity of Sports Games for students and teachers involved vocational education in the Baltic States. After getting acquainted with the representative of Estonian vocational education - a very athletic gentleman – I thought to myself: *"Now is the right time to start the negotiations"*. The choice was right, the support was received immediately. *"If Tallinn does not involve after a few months (the games were in autumn of the same year) then there are three educational institutions in Tartu and Estonia will have a team"*, summarizes Mr Šokman.

Now only half of the problem had to be solved, that is, contact the Lithuanian colleagues. The last name of the contact person was received from Mārtiņš Kaņepējs, the Director of the Study Content Department of the Ministry of Education and Science (Latvia). As a result, sports club AMI management received a kind invitation from Algirdas Pauliukonis, the Head of the Vocational Education Department of the Ministry of Education (Lithuania). In October 1993 the first foreign trip to Vilnius took place authorized by the management of the sports club AMI (Chairman of the Board and Public Deputy - Arnis Gulmanis – the Headmaster of Valmiera Vocational Secondary School No.36 and Austrā Zolte – the Headmistress of Riga Vocational Secondary School No.16).

Juozas Chmeliauskas, the Headmaster of the Vilnius School of Railway and a high-class table tennis player, welcomed us and accommodated in the school's hostel.

Representatives of the sports club AMI and V.Šokman met in Mr Pauliukonis office and agreed to organize the Baltic States Sports Games for the students and teachers of vocational education. The first regulations of the sports games were discussed and written - the **1st Baltic States Sports Games** will take place in Riga from 1 – 3 November 1993, after only a month. Basketball and table tennis for young women, young men and employees.

On the way home, initiator group of sports club AMI was already making plans about how to complete the task we imposed on ourselves. It was simple - money, sports centre with accommodation options and judges are needed. It was all successfully managed - the Sports Department of the Ministry of Education (Director Žorzs Tikmers) helped with the money at that time. Silvija Voitišķis, Headmistress of Riga Vocational School No. 34 (today Riga Style and Fashion Vocational School) was ready to take care of sports center, accommodation and catering. On the other hand, the game program was provided by Riga Vocational Secondary

School No. 16 (lead by A. Zolte), but the Head judge was Jānis Valneris (sports organizer from Riga State Technical School), a member of the sports club AMI Board. Awarding diplomas were borrowed from the Youth Sports Centre.

Of course, not all went perfectly - the money was enough only for modest rewarding and catering, everything else was organized basing on enthusiasm, but at that time the key was THE BEGINNING - the 1st Baltic States Sports Games in Vocational Education took place. It should be noted that the moral support was received from the Ministry of Education and Vocational Training Department (Latvia) in the person of Āris Bišers.

The 2nd Sports Games take place in the spring of 1994, Tartu (the first sports games experience showed that autumn is the beginning of the school year and is not the best time for such a large event) at V.Šokman. Employees' volleyball (mixed team) was added to the game program after the suggestion of the Estonian colleagues. Things were simple in Tartu, so to speak, on their own initiative.

In the spring of 1995 we were preparing on our way to Vilnius, for **the 3rd Baltic States Sports Games**, in the lead of A.Pauliukonis, where V. Šokman addresses the games' participants with now historic words: *"We succeeded! The first round of organizing the Baltic States Sports Games is now complete. Let it roll!"* And so it has happened. We have already completed eight rounds. It's already spring of 2017 and we - Sports Club AMI - together with the partners in Jelgava, are starting the ninth round by organizing 25th Sports Games once again in Latvia.

But how did we, the three Baltic countries sports promoters in vocational education, have organized, kept, developed the sports games during all these 25 years?

Agreed, the time period is long enough and changes have taken place not only in sports organization, but also in vocational education in the Baltic States. We have gone together through the economic crisis, when it seemed we should put an end to the games, but one thing at a time:

The 4th Sports Games of 1996 were organised in Liepaja on the basis of Vocational Secondary School No.48 (Headmistress Ērika Zīle). Small support was received from Liepaja City Council – it was possible to use the gym facility of Secondary School No. 15. The payment for judges, awarding and partial catering were financed by AMI sports club. The rest was financed by vocational secondary school.

The 5th Sports Games of 1997. Tallin, Tallin Vocational Secondary School. A public sports organization was established in Estonia, led by Tiit Kaber. The event was more solemn – the first five years.

The 6th Sports Games of 1998. Klaipeda. The games were took place in the united vocational educational institutions of Klaipeda. The guidance was undertaken by Vilnius Vocational Education Sports Club "Gintaras", its leader Danas Pozniakas (Olympic medallist in boxing).

After five years of organizing the sports games it was understood that in order to improve the games organization according to the regulations it is necessary to arrange the meeting of representatives of the three participating countries before the games. Such kind of meeting took place in Klaipeda before the 6th sports games under the leadership of A. Pauliukonis. During the meeting D. Pozniakas suggested to include a competition between the headmasters of the educational institutions in the program of sports games. To get acquainted with sport centres, housing conditions, catering facilities, etc. has become an integral part of the games since Klaipeda. After the 6th Baltic States Sports Games in Klaipeda, the games have become a kind of a unique sports event, where the students, educators and headmasters are competing side by side.

The innovations mentioned previously have become viable and traditional, however, the game program is still being updated, clarified.

The 7th Sports Games of 1999. Daugavpils. Daugavpils Vocational Secondary School No. 1 (Headmaster R. Ošmjanskis), Daugavpils Trade School (Headmaster G. Grāvelis) and Daugavpils Railway Transport Technical School (Headmaster R. Maculēvčs). The Baltic Sports Games were financed by LR Ministry of Science and Education for the first time

thanks to Ilmārs Vālodze the Director of Vocational Education Department who announced that AMI sports club has demonstrated a selfless work and the Ministry of Science and Education must also help. Of course the level of organization, the quality of judges, awarding, and game design increased.

The 8th sports games of 2000. Tartu. Tartu Vocational Secondary School. Headmaster V. Šokman. The guests from Finland promote international popularity.

The 9th Sports Games of 2001. Kaunas. Kaunas Vocational Education Institutions' Centre weaves the flag of the games under the guidance of A. Pauliukonis which becomes the symbol of Baltic Sports Games.

The 10th Sports Games of 2002. Jelgava. Jelgava Technical Lyceum (Headmistress Zaige Bensone), the head judge - Imants Šillers. For the first time all three Baltic States Secretaries of Ministry of Education arrived on the game's opening: A.Sarnovičs (Latvia), M.Lepojoe (Estonia), D.Numgandis (Lithuania). A solemn games opening takes place, the teams in the same uniforms, special diplomas with the signature of K. Greiškals, the Minister of Ministry of Education and Science (Latvia), as well as games' logo, medals, cups. The teams were supported by the presence of Gunārs Krusts, the director of the Vocational Education Department. The organization of the games becomes an important event for students, employees and headmasters of vocational education in Latvia.

The 11th Sports Games of 2003. Tartu. The sports teachers Tiit Kaber and Peter Kikas were taking part actively.

The 12th Sports games of 2004. Kuršeniai (Lithuania). Under the guidance of the athletic Headmistress R.Rupšiene (Champion of the 13th Baltic Sports Games).

The 13th Sports Games of 2005. Valmiera. Valmiera Vocational Secondary School No. 36 (Headmaster G. Bilsēns), Valmiera Food Processing Secondary School (Headmaster Ē.Spuriņš). The schools being under the subordination of the Ministry of Agriculture (Latvia) are passed to the Ministry of Education and Science but sports comes under the sports club AMI. The quality of sports games organization continues to improve, the local government also involves by helping with the sporting base and organizing a concert for the participants.

The 14th Sports Games of 2006. Tartu. A sports federation of vocational education is established in Estonia. Tiit Tammaru becomes Secretary-General who proposed to write and affirm the regulations for three years. Till then it was approved during the tripartite meeting every year. Tiit Tammaru also drafted the regulations in English. The procedure of the games

organization was systematized, requirements for the judges' qualifications and accommodation conditions increased, as well as the logo should be designed for every game.

The 15th Sports Games of 2007. Alauta (Lithuania). No special celebration organised but everything continues. Lithuanian Youth Sports Centre methodologist Zigmas Badaras actively participates in organization.

The 16th Sports Games of 2008. Kandava. For the first time the games took place in Kandava Technical School under the guidance of Ivars Lasis supported by Kandava City Council. I.Lasis drafts the games' logo and diplomas. Everything is controlled (*in a positive sense*) I.Simanoviča the director of the Ministry of Science and Education (Latvia). The games were opened by M.Gruškevičs the State Secretary and closed by K. Vāgnere the Deputy. Everyone is satisfied!

The 17th Sports Games of 2009. Should be held in Estonia, but the Baltic States fall into economic crisis. What to do? Wait? Pause? Agreed with Tiit Tammaru that organization of the games should not be stopped because the renewal is far more complicated. Decided that the games could take place in Viljandi Vocational Secondary School – on appropriate level of the economic possibilities. Estonia determines the need of a participation fee. Till 2009 the organizers were completely responsible for the organization of the games, teams just had to arrive. The delegation consisted of 72 participants from each country. Both Lithuanian colleagues and we understood that the idea must be supported. It was announced to the Ministry of Education and Science (Latvia) that the finances for the Baltic States sports games will be necessary not only every three years for organization, but also for participating - 1.400 €. The opinion of the Ministry of Education and Science was very pleasing. There will be full support, because sports plays an important role in the vocational education. The games took place with a great support from the headmaster of Viljandi School, for example, hand - made prizes.

Let's continue.

The 18th Sports Games of 2010. Alytas. The sports management changes in Lithuania. D.Pozniakas had left this world, Z.Badaras - retired. The games organization is entrusted to the new Lithuanian Youth Sports Centre instructor - I.Rumbauskaite. It is not easy, but the strength lies in traditions.

The 19th Sports Games of 2011. Ventspils. The grandest sports games of all times, organised in close collaboration of Kristīne Vāgnere the State Secretary of the Ministry of Education and and Guntis Blumbergs the Vice-President of Ventspils City Council. A magnificent opening event, cultural program, special medals and diplomas, judges, the training facilities, housing conditions. All the national officials of the Ministry of Education participate in the games. The games were opened by Rolands Broks – the Minister of the Ministry of Education and Science and the Aldonis Vrubļevskis the president of the Olympic Committee. Latvian educational institutions advertise the learning opportunities in vocational education. Participants were provided free time leisure activities: waterpark, planetarium and other places in Ventspils. On the day of the games Ventspils became like a showcase place for sports and cultural work of vocational education. The idea of vocational skills competition for students is promoted alongside with sports activities.

The 20th Sports Games of 2012. Tartu. A festivity for the participants and the opening concert full of different creations is organized in Tartu Science and Innovation Centre "AHA". Possibility to try out all the opportunities offered by the Centre. Founders of the games: V.Šokman, A.Pauliukonis, I.Bukovska receive memorial prizes. Also I.Štāla, the State Secretary of the Ministry of Education, and Scinence and K.Vāgnere, Headmistress of Ventspils Technical School, are honoured. Parallel with the sports games a competition in professional skills contest in web design takes place, all three member states' participants are competing. Representatives from Latvia under the supervision of Ina Vārna (Deputy Director of the Ministry of Education and Science Department) and performance of Ilze Brante (Headmistress of Ogre Technical School) - beautiful billboards about vocational education opportunities in Latvia are prepared. However, for the time being this sphere is not promoted though provided in the regulations. All possibilities...

The 21st Sports Games of 2013. Panevežys. There were reforms in the Lithuanian Youth Sports Centre. The succession did not follow. A great silence reigned on the Lithuanian side a month before the games. Again, what to do? A.Pauliukonis – retired, the Head of the Vocational Education Management in the Ministry had also changed, but the acquainted State Secretary of the 10th Sports Games is still in position.

D.Numgaudis, the State Secretary of the Ministry of education (Lithuania) must be bothered, the situation explained and a positive acknowledgment received. As a result, the games took place in Panevežys, in the sports base centre. The games were entrusted to organize to Gintaras Prunskus, methodologist of the Lithuanian non - formal education centre. Baptism by fire, but the main thing - the games continue.

The 22nd Sports Games of 2014. Smiltene, Smiltene Technical School (Headmaster A.Miezītis). During the tripartite meeting Estonians suggested an innovation: replace employees' volleyball with girls' volleyball. Of course not everyone was enthusiastic, but way must be given to the younger generation. A warm-hearted atmosphere was felt throughout the games. The games were opened by Andis Geižāns, Parliamentary Secretary of the Ministry of Education and Science. L. Reiniks warmed up the participants with his song "I run", especially Lithuanians and Estonians liked it. The Head judge of the games - Leons Peļņa.

The 23rd Sports Games of 2015. Viljandi. In Viljandi sports center. The games organization was well thought-out. The participants must just show their athletic performance.

The 24th Sports Games of 2016. Kedainiai. In the beautiful hall of Kedainiai sports centre. Lithuanians had prepared a variety of gifts for the best athletes, accommodation in the city hotels.

The 25th Sports Games of 2017. Jelgava - for the second time. The work put in is in accordance with the game number. Everyone working together: the Ministry of Education and Science, Jelgava City Council, Jelgava Technical School, Jelgava Sports Centre. The students of Ogre Technical School drafted the logo of the games, diplomas, game tables, accreditation cards and other representational materials. Janīna Rudzīte, Headmistress of Jelgava technical School, holds her hand on the increasing pulse. The new regulations of 2018 – 2020 were discussed during the tripartite meeting in Jelgava, and again an innovation suggested by G. Prunskus – to organize streetball for both men and women instead of employee (men) basketball. New challenges ahead!

It cannot be denied that the importance of the games for students, employees and the headmasters has only grown. Over the 25 years about 1000 participants from 70 different educational institutions from Latvia have taken part in the games, similar numbers are likely in Lithuania and Estonia.

Sports teachers, teacher-trainers input is priceless in team preparation. From the very beginning of the games this work was taken up by Jānis Valneris (sports organizer of Riga State Technical Gymnasium) and Jānis Nipers (Deputy Director) - basketball for employees and boys. Aina Legzdiņa (sports organizer of Riga Vocational Secondary School No.5) organises basketball for girls, Kārlis Bēms (sports organizer of Aizkraukle Vocational Secondary School) - volleyball for employees, Arnolds Kovaļevskis (sports organizer of Daugavpils Trade School) - volleyball for boys, in the later years Raitis Silarājs (sports teacher of Ventspils Technical School) - basketball for boys.

Generational change takes place in the Latvian coach usual tandems in the last years. For the third year basketball for boys is in the hands of Kārlis Pavlovs sports teacher of Saldus Technical School (a player in the employees team), Ģirts Magone (sports organizer of Riga State Technical College) and Mārtiņš Zemturis (sports teacher of Riga State Technical College) are responsible for the success of girls basketball team (both employees team player). In volleyball, Vladimirs Pupels (sports organizer of Daugavpils Technical School) joined A.Kovaļevskis - both responsible for the boys and girls volleyball teams.

The role of the headmasters of educational institutions in organizing the Baltic States Sports Games is priceless.

Sport - it is eternal youth that is always with the person said P.Jusins.

And that is a profound truth, who understands it is surrounded by the joy of life, activity, energy and development.

I am grateful to the Headmasters of Latvian, Lithuanian and Estonian educational institutions who have organized the Baltic Sports games in Latvia, ensured students and employees partaking, participated themselves and promoted the joy of victory.

I am thankful to all the coaches, teachers, sports centre managers, and the Baltic States Ministries of Education for the awareness, understanding and support.

Agreeing with Jānis Velneris, head judge of the 1st Games, sports club AMI Honorary board member, Honorary coach and Honorary head judge: *"The Baltic States Sports Games were and are one of the unifying events of students and employees of vocational education particularly during the third awakening period of the Baltic States. Therefore, faster, higher, stronger!"*
